

## Heidi Crebo-Rediker

Heidi Crebo-Rediker is an adjunct senior fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations. She is also the chief executive officer of International Capital Strategies. Prior to this, she served as the State Department's first chief economist, an assistant secretary-level position. She provided advice and analysis to Secretary Hillary Clinton on foreign policy issues with a significant economic or financial component.



Prior to this, Heidi Crebo-Rediker was the chief of international finance and economics for the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations, where she advised then Chairman John Kerry on a range of international and domestic economic and financial issues; she also was the architect of the bipartisan National Infrastructure Bank legislation (BUILD Act) introduced in March 2011 and included in President Barack Obama's JOBS Act.


Over her investment banking career, Heidi Crebo-Rediker managed businesses ranging from European and emerging-markets debt capital markets to sovereign, supranational, and public-sector banking. She was named one of the Top 25 Women in Business by the Wall Street Journal Europe. She holds degrees from Dartmouth College and the London School of Economics.
